23.3 Area 72 submit the following Proposed Agenda Item for consideration at the General Service Conference: "The General Service Board develop supplemental reporting focused on the actual costs of the various service items we provide, with an initial draft being brought back to the Conference Committee on Finance for review at the General Service Conference." **PASSED**
